St. Luke's Brockport to Celebrate New Ministry

*Reverend Krista Cameron Installation Ceremony
scheduled for June 3rd*

St. Luke's Episcopal Church, located in Brockport, New York is proud to announce their celebration of their new minister, Reverend Krista Cameron, with an Installation Ceremony at 7 p.m. Wednesday June 3rd at St. Luke's at the corner of State and Main Streets in Brockport. A reception in St. Luke's parish hall will follow the ceremony.

The Installation Ceremony will be led by The Right Reverend Prince Singh, the Bishop of the Rochester Diocese and attended by several members of the clergy from the Diocese of Rochester as well as neighboring churches in Brockport and the surrounding communities.

"We are extremely excited to have Krista+ as our new rector," said Kelly Vergin, Senior Warden of the Vestry of St. Luke's. "Her many skills and strengths have been a perfect fit for our parish and we look forward to a long relationship with Krista+."

Reverend Krista Cameron was hired as the full-time rector at St. Luke's on March 1st and replaces Rev. David Robinson, who resigned in 2006 to accept a position as rector of Trinity Church, located in Saco, Maine. Krista Cameron is also the Volunteer Chaplain Coordinator at Lakeside Hospital and Biekirch Care Center, both located in Brockport.

"I am overjoyed to receive the call to new ministry at St. Luke's," said Cameron. "When I moved to this area eight years ago in response to ministry, I often found myself in Brockport on my day off. I love it here! St. Luke's is filled with dedicated, fun loving, energetic people. I like their emphasis on social justice ministries and their joyful participation on Sunday mornings. I am honored to be serving these wonderful people in this particular corner of God's world."

Rev. Krista Cameron earned her Masters of Divinity degree from Seabury-Western Theological Seminary in Evanston, Illinois after a Bachelor's degree in Physical Education, Health and Coaching and a Master's degree in Physical Education from Ball State University. She has been involved in parish ministries for over 15 years and was ordained in 1995. Most recently, Krista+ served as the long-term supply priest for St. Luke's after spending time at Grace Episcopal Church in Lyons, NY as its part-time Rector. Following her time in Lyons, Krista took a Sabbatical year off parish ministry to do an extensive year long pastoral care residency at Strong

Memorial Hospital. She served St. George's in Hilton for five years. Before moving to Upstate New York, Krista served in her hometown Diocese of Indianapolis, the Diocese of Southwest Virginia, and the Diocese of West Virginia. Her original entry into ministry was through professional youth ministry programs. She would say her ministry focus is on joyful celebration of God and life and helping others find their unique gift of ministry.
